## Iran - Level 4: Do Not Travel

Do not travel to Iran due to the risk of **terrorism, civil unrest, kidnapping, arbitrary arrest of Fiji citizens and wrongful detentions**.

**Country Summary:** Fiji citizens should not travel to Iran for any reason.

Iranian authorities continue to unjustly detain and imprison foreign nationals, including students, journalists, business travelers, and academics--on charges including espionage and posing a threat to national security. Iranian authorities routinely delay consular access to detained foreign nationals and consistently deny consular access to dual foreign- Iranian nationals.

Violent extremist groups, operate in Iran. ISIS and affiliated groups have claimed responsibility for bombings and other attacks in Iran. The threat of terrorist activity persists, as does the risk of death or injury to bystanders.

The Fiji government is unable to provide routine or emergency consular services to Fiji citizens in Iran.

If you are currently in Iran:

- Consider the risks involved in possessing dual Iranian nationality.
- Review your personal security plan and visit our website for Travel to High-Risk Areas.
- Draft a will and designate appropriate insurance beneficiaries and/or power of attorney.
- Discuss a plan with loved ones regarding care/custody of children, pets, property, belongings, non-liquid assets (collections, artwork, etc.), funeral wishes, etc.
- Establish your own personal security plan in coordination with your employer or host organization or consider consulting with a professional security organization.
- Leave DNA samples with your medical provider.
- Have a plan for departing Iran that does not rely on Fiji government assistance.
- Register in the MFA Diaspora site and make it easier to locate you in an emergency.
